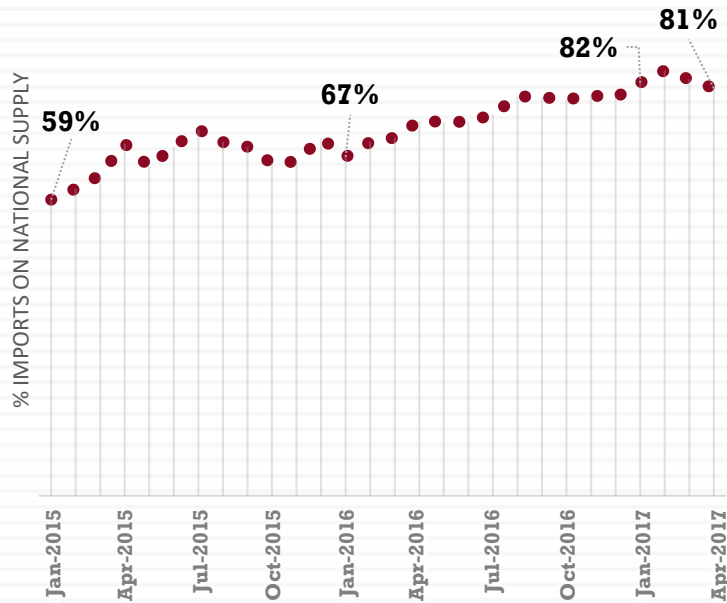


Mexico imports 81% of natural gas consumption.

- On April, 2017 Mexico's natural gas supply without considering the national oil company's consumption, reached 5,810 million of standard cubic feet daily (mmscfd), of which 4,683 mmscfd were imports, that represents 81%.
- In early 2015 imports were 59% of natural gas supply and on February 2017 reached their highest level on 84%.
- Pemex produced 3,218 mmscfd, and its consumption was reported as 1,936 mmscfd, that represents 60% of its production.

Note: Natural gas supply isn't considering Pemex consumption.
