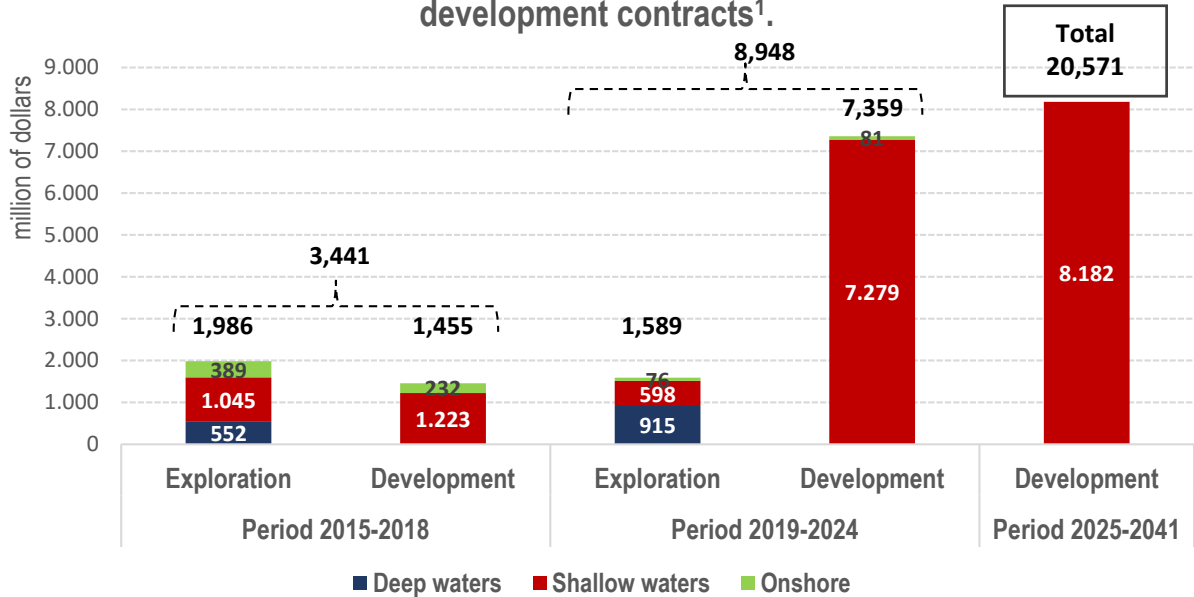




# CNH has approved more than \$20 billion dollars of investment in contract plans

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Investments approved by CNH in plans for exploration and development contracts<sup>1</sup>.



- Investment approved by the CNH in plans for exploration and development contracts<sup>1</sup> amounts to US\$20.571 billion. Of this amount, US\$3.441 billion in investments are programmed for the first three years (2015-2018), US\$8.948 billion for the following six years (2019-2024) and US\$8.182 billion for the period 2025-2041.
- Of the approved investment, US\$3.574 billion correspond to exploration activities<sup>2</sup> and US\$16.997 billion to development activities. In addition, US\$18.326 billion correspond to contracts located in shallow waters, US\$1.467 billion in deep waters and US\$778 million in onshore projects.
- The CNH updates and publishes information related to the investments scheduled in the plans through the Information System of Hydrocarbons (SIH), available at: <https://portal.cnih.cnh.gob.mx/dashboard-sih.php>. The information can be found in the section of economic indicators disaggregated by contract, state, oil basin and costs, noting that:
  - 91.2% of approved investments are concentrated in the Southeast Basin, while Deep Gulf projects receive 7.1% of investment.
  - More than 90% of approved investments correspond to contracts located in Tabasco and Campeche.
