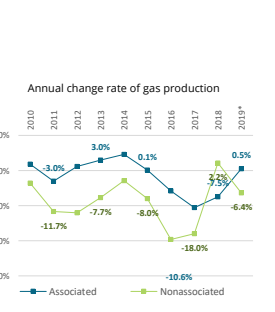
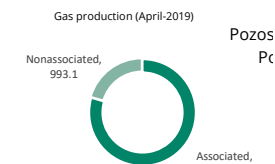
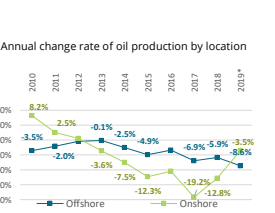
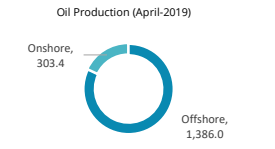


National Oil and Gas Production

As result, since 2018 all operators now report under such conditions. Production corresponds to total volumes of hydrocarbons extracted.
