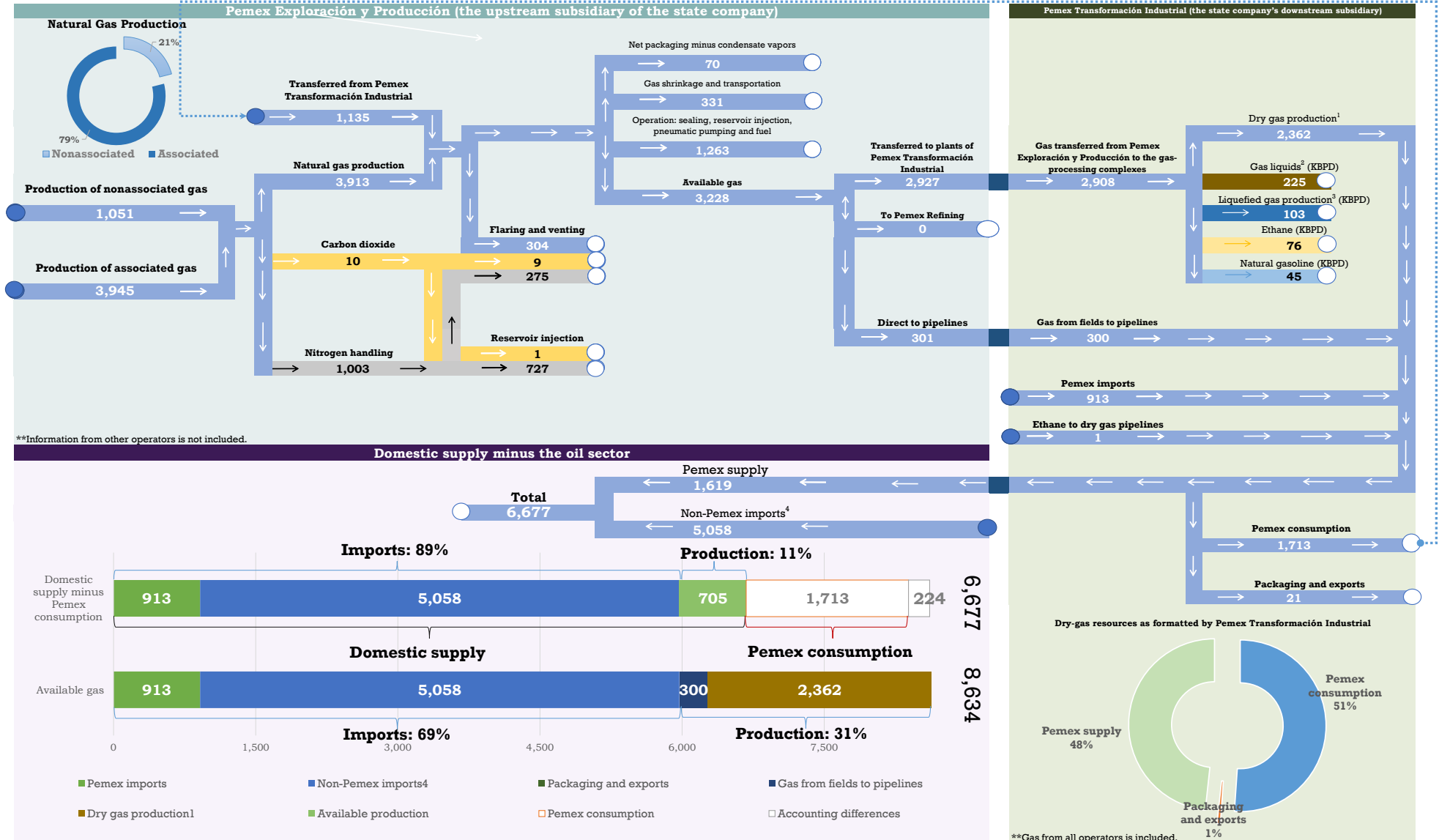


NATIONAL HYDROCARBONS COMMISSION Natural Gas Balance (September 2019)

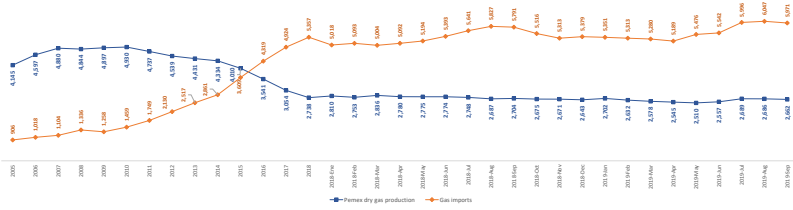

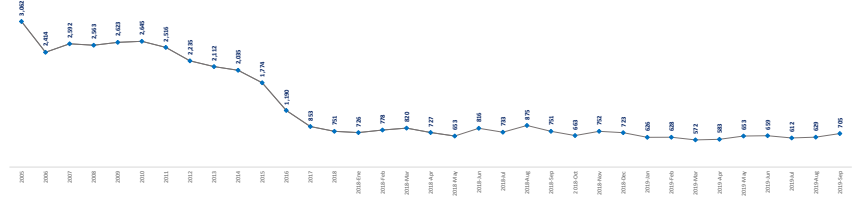
